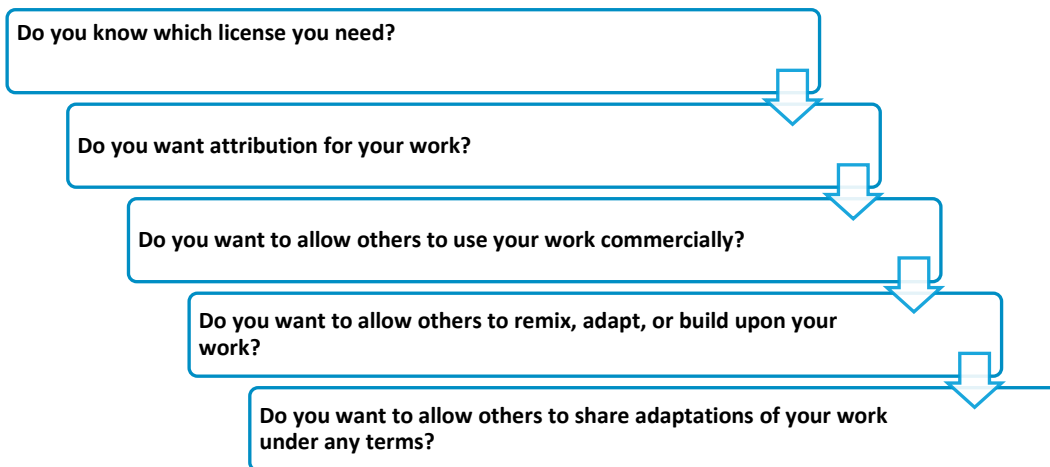

### 3.2. ASSIGNING CREATIVE COMMONS LICENSE TO PERSONAL AND DERIVATIVE RESOURCES

Once you know the licence restrictions and options, you can decide how you want your work to be published, used and shared. The system provides a list of questions that will automatically generate a Creative Commons licence for you. Equally, these questions might serve as guidelines and important factors to reconsider when thinking about how you want your work to be published, used and shared.

Questions to reconsider:



Based on the answers you select to each of these questions, the system will automatically generate and recommend a license that you can copy and add to the website or any other print work or media.
